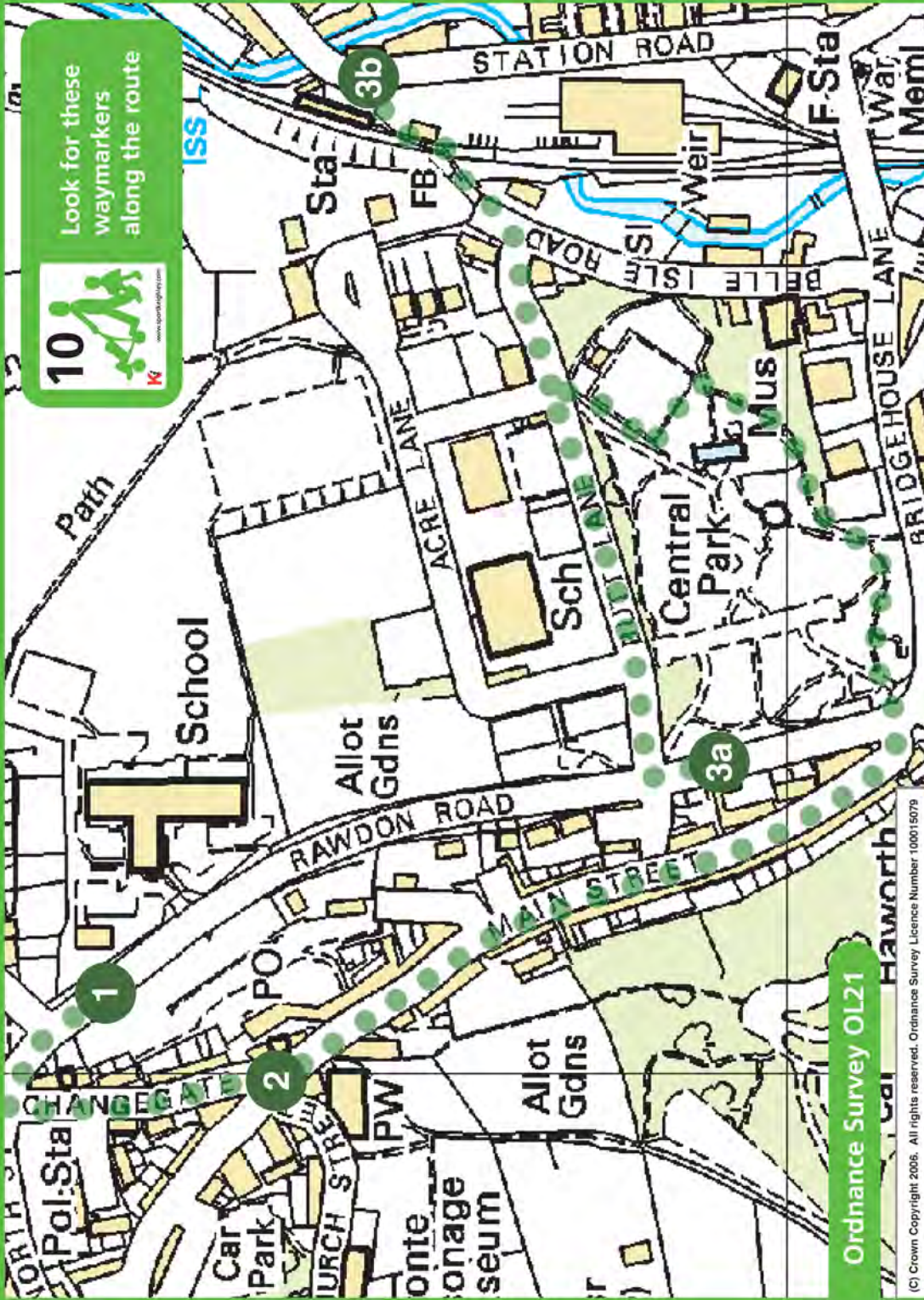

The Route:

- 1 Start from Rawdon Road top opposite the School outside the surgery, turn left and walk up and round to the left in to Changegate. Turn left and walk along Changegate to the top of Haworth Main Street and the church.
- 2 Turn left and walk down Main Street, at the bottom turn to your left and cross over the road to the park entrance by the public toilets. Enter the park and walk down following the paths on the right down through the flowerbeds to the children's play area. To leave the park walk past the play area and past the bowling green out on to Butt Lane.
- 3 From Butt lane you have a choice,
 - 3a Either turn left and walk up Butt Lane and then turn right to walk up to the bus stop to return to Keighley or
 - 3b Turn right and walk down Butt Lane and walk over the Worth Valley Railway Bridge on the left and then past the railway station on to Mill Hey. There is a bus stop on the right to return to Keighley



Points to note

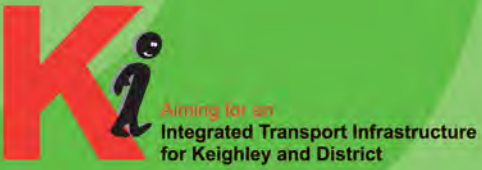
- Do not confuse the markers on the enclosed map with any way marker symbols you may see placed along the actual walk. The numbered markers shown on the map are to give approximate location on the route with the numbered written instructions.
- Although accessible for pushchairs some sections of the walk are over cobbled streets.

Places of interest

Haworth Main Street, Haworth Church and Haworth Park.

Transport to walk

Buses from to Keighley are regular ask for the stop on Rawdon Road top.



The Keighley Walking Initiative

Grades of walks available:



Mild to moderate, suitable for pushchairs. Usually less than 3.5km.



Mild to moderate, not suitable for pushchairs. Usually less than 3.5km.



Moderate. Usually less than 6.5km.



Hard. Usually over 6.5km.
