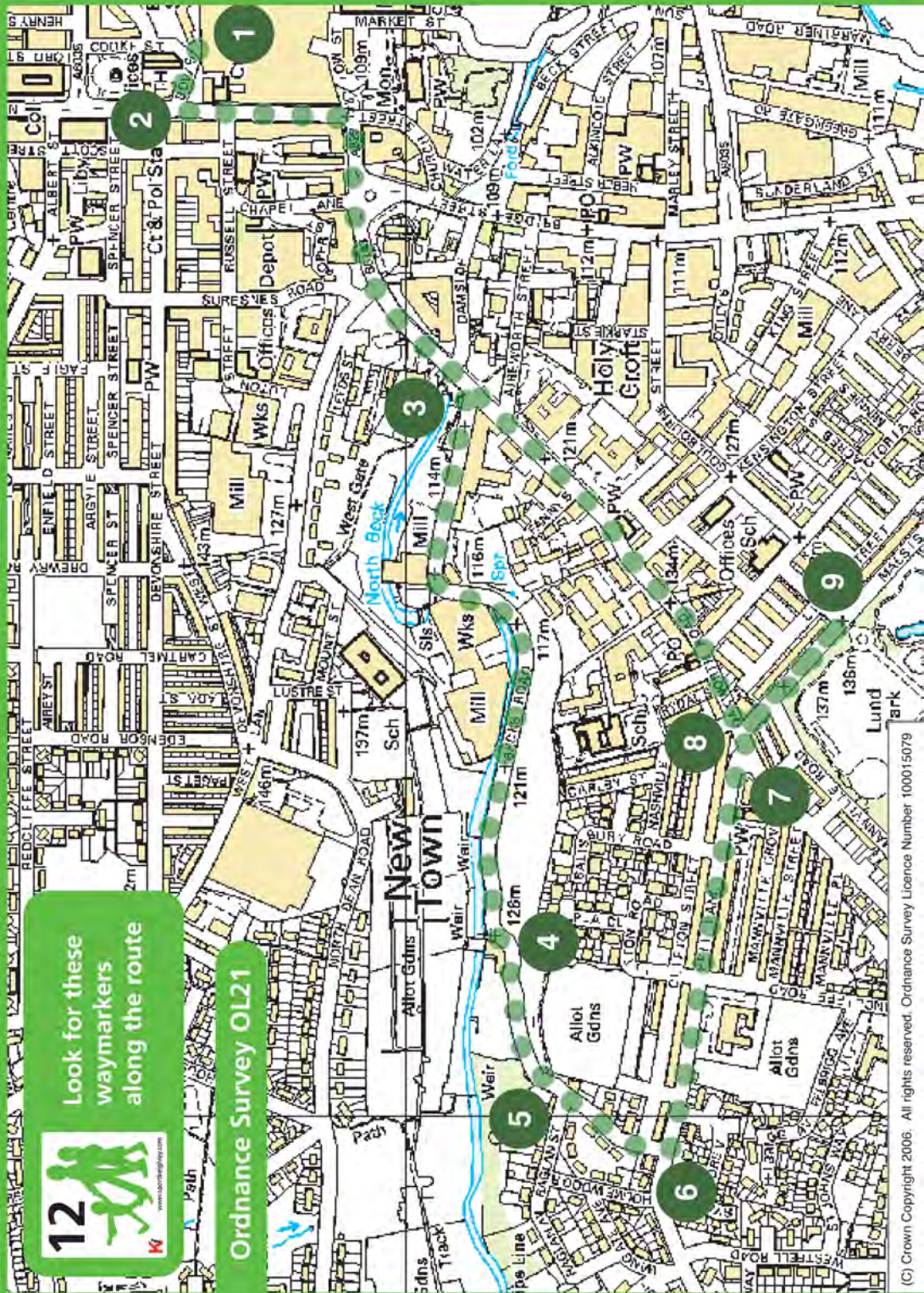

The Route:

- 1 Leave the bus station at the top entrance facing north Street, walk up Bow Street on to North Street cross over at the large crossing.
- 2 Turn left and walk along North Street turning right to the roundabout. Continue on the same side of the road to walk up Oakworth Road. Cross the bottom of West Lane and carry on up Oakworth Road until coming to Becks Road (ignore the footpath sign before Becks Road) Becks Road is the next turning right.
- 3 Follow Becks Road past the huge old Mill buildings, Becks road now winds round to the left go through the Vehicle barrier at the left side to continue to walk on Becks road. The road is now surfaced with limestone hardcore not tarmac and you follow the road with the North beck running along your right side. You will come to another ruined mill building here the road bends again to the left leaving the beck. Follow the road on and then up keeping to your left through the trees.
- 4 You will arrive at a gate at the top by the house. Go through the opening at the side of the gate and walk between the two houses.
- 5 Here you will see some bungalows on the right, carry on keeping to the left walk along the road passing in front of the bungalows out on to Fell Lane.
- 6 Fell Lane is a long road, turn left and walk all the way to the end coming back in to Oakworth Road.
- 7 Cross over Oakworth road and turn right walking a short way up Oakworth Road until reaching Malsis Crescent on the left.
- 8 Walk along Malsis Crescent and turn to the right you will see an entrance in to Lund Park.
- 9 Explore the Park, to exit Lund Park walk down the large central tree lined path to the large stone gateposts marking the main entrance to the park. Go through the gateposts and turn left to walk to the end of Malsis Road back on to Oakworth Road. Here turn right and follow Oakworth Road back down in to Keighley Town centre then retrace your steps back along North Street in to the bus station.



Points to note

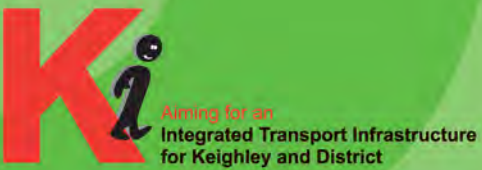
- Do not confuse the markers on the enclosed map with any way marker symbols you may see placed along the actual walk. The numbered markers shown on the map are to give approximate location on the route with the numbered written instructions.
- No public toilets on this route only in the bus station at the start and finish of the walk.

Places of interest

Lund Park has a Bowling Green, skate/ bike track and two children's play areas.
